I. MAPS 3 Convention Center and Hotel

- Convention Center Site Led acquisition team. 19 parcels acquired; 3 in negotiation, 3 filed condemnations.
- Convention Center Hotel
 - o Selection committee recommends Omni.
 - Began process of site acquisition.
 - Council Presentation on hotel proposals and possible funding sources.
- Participate in identification of recommended site for parking garage to serve convention center, MAPS 3 Park, Chesapeake Arena & Convention Center Hotel.
 - Research possibility of private development in conjunction with garage.

II. Job Creation
